CIRCA FACULTY RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP CALL FOR PROPOSALS FOR SPRING 2018 SEMESTER

Application Deadline: October 2, 2017

The Center for Innovation, Research and Creativity in the Arts (CIRCA) invites applications for up to two Faculty Research Fellowships for the Spring 2018 semester. Funding is intended to support and promote significant Arts research at UMBC. CIRCA Faculty Research Fellows will receive release from teaching in the selected semester (up to two course releases) in order to work on a substantial project or the training necessary to embark on such a project. Faculty wishing to develop expertise in a new practice or technique are also encouraged to apply.

Fellows will be required to introduce their new research initiatives in a public CIRCA *Presents* program by late April. Fellows will also be expected to actively participate whenever possible in the life of the Arts at the university, including CIRCA *Catalyst* presentations, exhibitions, concerts, recitals and lectures. A short report on fellowship activity will be due to the director by September 1, 2018. After their fellowship semester Fellows will also be expected to serve for a two-year term on the CIRCA review panel.

CIRCA welcomes proposals from all full-time, tenured and tenure-track faculty members pursuing Arts research in the College of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences. Applications are open to fulltime faculty with appointments in Dance, Music, Theater and Visual Arts at UMBC. Proposals will be reviewed by the CIRCA review panel, with decisions finalized and communicated by the director by November 1, 2017. The director will work with the department chair and dean of CAHSS to address service workloads during the fellowship semester.

Evaluation Criteria:

Proposals will be reviewed by a review panel convened by the director of CIRCA. Applications will be judged on the degree to which they meet the stated purpose of this fellowship program. Criteria include:

- Evidence that faculty members are qualified to carry out the work of the project during the fellowship term, are active and productive researchers in the field, and have the necessary skills and background to move toward dissemination of the work and/or secure external support;
- Release from teaching will allow a faculty person to complete a work already in progress, or;
- Forge significant new directions in the faculty person's research program;
- All proposals must have the recommendation of the faculty member's Department Chair and a ranking from the Chair if there is more than one proposal from the department.

Application:

Applicants should complete and submit: the CIRCA Faculty Research Fellowship application form (including the applicant and chair signatures); CIRCA Faculty Research Fellowship proposal (following the format guidelines); and CV in UMBC format. The faculty member's department chair should email separately a one-paragraph recommendation and ranking (if more than one proposal is submitted per department). All proposals must have the recommendation of the faculty member's department chair. Finished applications should be emailed (complete with all attachments) to Carol Harmon, <u>harmon@umbc.edu</u>, by close of business on <u>October 2, 2017</u>. The chair's evaluation (and ranking if required) should be received no later than <u>October 9, 2017</u>.

DIRECTIONS FOR SUBMITTING PROPOSAL AND APPLICATION FORM

The CIRCA Faculty Research Fellowship proposal must be formatted as follows and include:

- FORMAT: Double-spaced, with one-inch margins, using a 12-point font.
- TITLE PAGE (cover page): Title of proposal, applicant's name, and department or program.
- SUMMARY (half page): This should be written in non-technical language. Please keep in mind that all reviewers may not be experts in your field.
- TEXT (limited to two pages; texts exceeding limit will not be considered): Include a clear and concise statement of the specific aims and significance of the proposed creative research or scholarship. The applicant should clearly note how the CIRCA Faculty Research Fellowship will be used to develop or complete the applicant's research. Applicants should address the project's: importance to the field; potential for external funding; scope of dissemination (regional, national, or international venues); innovation and creativity; plan for successful completion.
- DOCUMENTATION **(one page)**: Provide relevant Internet links and/or brief profiles describing funders, venues, publishers, exhibitors, etc. that you will draw upon to fund, present, document, disseminate, and/or exhibit your research, or, to embark in significantly new directions.
- CURRICULUM VITAE OF APPLICANT. Follow the UMBC format guidelines available at http://cahss.umbc.edu/curriculum-vitae-format/ and attach to the CIRCA/CAHSS SFRF submission email as a separate Word or PDF document.
