

CIRCA FACULTY PEDAGOGY FELLOWSHIP (CFPF)
CALL FOR PROPOSALS FOR FALL 2019 or SPRING 2020 SEMESTERS
Application Deadline: April 16, 2019

The Center for Innovation, Research and Creativity in the Arts (CIRCA) invites applications from full-time Lecturers, Senior Lecturers, Instructors, and tenured and tenure-track faculty members in the Arts (Dance, Music, Theatre, Visual Arts) for the CIRCA Faculty Pedagogy Fellowships for the Fall 2019 or Spring 2020 semesters. Faculty on visiting or short-term appointments are not eligible to apply. Funding is intended to support and promote significant Arts innovation in teaching at UMBC. One Pedagogy Fellow will receive release from teaching in the selected semester (up to two course releases) in order to work on the development of innovative new directions in undergraduate or graduate teaching, or the training necessary to embark on such work. Faculty wishing to develop expertise in a new practice or technique related to instruction are also encouraged to apply. The CFPF offers time to fully concentrate, renew teaching, and explore.

Fellows will be required to introduce their new initiatives in a public CIRCA program by April 30, 2020. Fellows will also be expected to actively participate whenever possible in the life of the arts at the university, including CIRCA presentations, exhibitions, concerts, recitals and lectures. A short report on fellowship activity will be due to the CIRCA Director by the first day of classes of the subsequent semester. Following their fellowship semester, Fellows will also be expected to serve for a two-year term on the CIRCA review panel.

Proposals will be reviewed by the CIRCA review panel, with decisions finalized and communicated by the CIRCA director by May 18, 2019. The director will work with the Department Chair and Dean of CAHSS to address service workloads during the fellowship semester.

Evaluation Criteria:

Proposals will be reviewed by a review panel convened by the Director of CIRCA. Applications will be judged on the degree to which they meet the stated purpose of this fellowship program. Criteria include evidence that:

- the faculty applicant is qualified to carry out the scope of the proposed activities during the fellowship term, is an active and productive instructor and/or researcher in the field, and has the necessary skills and background to move toward implementation in the classroom or studio;
- the fellowship release from teaching will allow the faculty person to complete a new direction in pedagogy or work already in progress in teaching innovation, or;
- the proposed work will forge significant new directions in the faculty person's teaching program;
- the application has the recommendation of the faculty member's Department Chair (and a ranking from the Chair if there is more than one proposal from the department).

Application:

Applicants should complete and submit: the CIRCA Faculty Pedagogy Fellowship application form (including the applicant and chair signatures); CIRCA CFPF proposal (following the format guidelines); and CV in UMBC format. All proposals must have the recommendation of the faculty member's department chair. The faculty member's department chair should email separately a one-paragraph recommendation and ranking (if more than one proposal is submitted per department). Finished applications should be emailed (complete with all attachments) to Carol Harmon, harmon@umbc.edu, by close of business on April 20, 2019. The chair's recommendation (and ranking if required) should be received no later than April 24, 2019.

DIRECTIONS FOR SUBMITTING APPLICATION FORM AND PROPOSAL:

The CIRCA Faculty Pedagogy Fellowship proposal must be formatted as follows and include:

- **FORMAT:** Double-spaced, with one-inch margins, using a 12-point font.
- **TITLE PAGE (cover page):** Title of proposal, applicant's name, and department or program.
- **SUMMARY (half page):** This should be written in non-technical language. Please keep in mind that all reviewers may not be experts in your field.
- **TEXT (limited to two pages; texts exceeding limit will not be considered):** Include a clear and concise statement of the specific aims and significance of the proposed creative research or scholarship in teaching. The applicant should clearly note how the CIRCA Faculty Pedagogy Fellowship will be used to develop or complete the applicant's proposed work. Applicants should address the work's: importance to the field; scope of dissemination (regional, national, or international venues); innovation and creativity; plan for successful implementation in the classroom or studio, and/or completion.
- **DOCUMENTATION (one page):** Provide relevant Internet links that you will draw upon to study, document, assess, and disseminate your program as you embark upon significantly new directions in technique and pedagogy.
- **CURRICULUM VITAE OF APPLICANT.** Follow the UMBC format guidelines available at <http://cahss.umbc.edu/curriculum-vitae-format/> and attach to the CIRCA/CAHSS SFRF submission email as a separate Word or PDF document.
